Bread Together is running a three week test production phase in late 2019. We would really value your subscription during this test period so that you can provide feedback and suggestions for improvement before we launch our bread to sell business more generally in Chester in early 2020.

We are a grassroots co-operative in Chester, set up after 8 years of community bread making in Chester. We promote an inclusive and empowering environment for individuals of any age to make bread together and to share skills on an equal basis. Our activities include regular public access bread making sessions; bespoke bread making workshops as well as one-off events. We are now adding a further strand to our work: selling bread by monthly subscription in central Chester. All our bread is made using locally sourced ingredients where possible, for example Walk Mill flour, and our products are vegan. Unfortunately, we are unable to cater for allergies.
